

Around the World and Right at Home

When Marsh Damerell began planning to sail around the world with his wife, Fran, she thought the idea would just go away. But Marsh, who had been in the Navy during WWII and Korea, had developed a yearning for the sea, and for long-distance sailing in particular. He and a friend had built a small boat in 1965, and when he began searching for a suitable long-distance cruising boat, Fran knew he was serious.

From 1980-83, the couple sailed around the world on their 38-foot ketch rigged sailboat. "It was fascinating!" Fran admits. It's not surprising that the couple, who comfortably finish each other's sentences, would get along anywhere. With their outgoing natures, they decided to create a narrated slide show, which incorporates 700 of the 3,000 slides they took during their 32,072-mile journey. The Damerells have presented the program 300 times, to yacht clubs, nursing homes, church groups and twice to Asbury~Solomons Island, where they've lived for two years.

The Damerells love it at Asbury~Solomons Island. Says Fran, "We've lived on the same river since 1987, and we can still see 'our river' from our home here." Marsh is particularly happy that Asbury accommodated the equipment he had collected after a career running

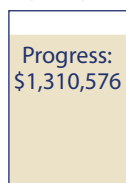

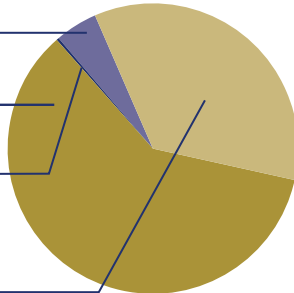

The Endowment

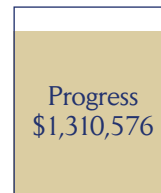

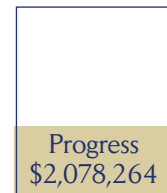
The Wellness Center that opened in 2002 is almost paid off, and our endowment continues to grow. Thank you for your continuing support!

Frequently Asked Questions About Our Endowment

Q: Who manages the Asbury Foundation's endowment funds?

The investment portfolio is managed by Russell Investment Group, who has been in existence for nearly 70 years and has developed an advanced, multimanager investing process that is a comprehensive approach to long-term investing. Russell also manages the assets of the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, the largest foundation in the world. Hired

by Asbury in 2003, Russell is a team of experts who guide and direct the Asbury Investment Committee to determine asset allocations and investment goals and decisions.

Q: What is the investment philosophy?

The investment portfolio is invested to diversify risk and seek long-term growth and appreciation. It includes a balance of equities and fixed-return assets. Over the last 10

years, the investment return has averaged 9.7 percent.

Q: Who oversees Russell Investment Group?

The Asbury Investment Committee, which is made up of Board members from Asbury Communities, its affiliates and the Asbury Foundation. It meets quarterly to review the investment portfolio and recommend adjustments.

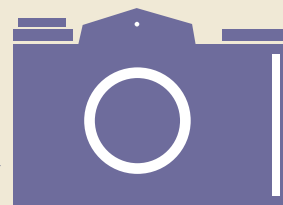

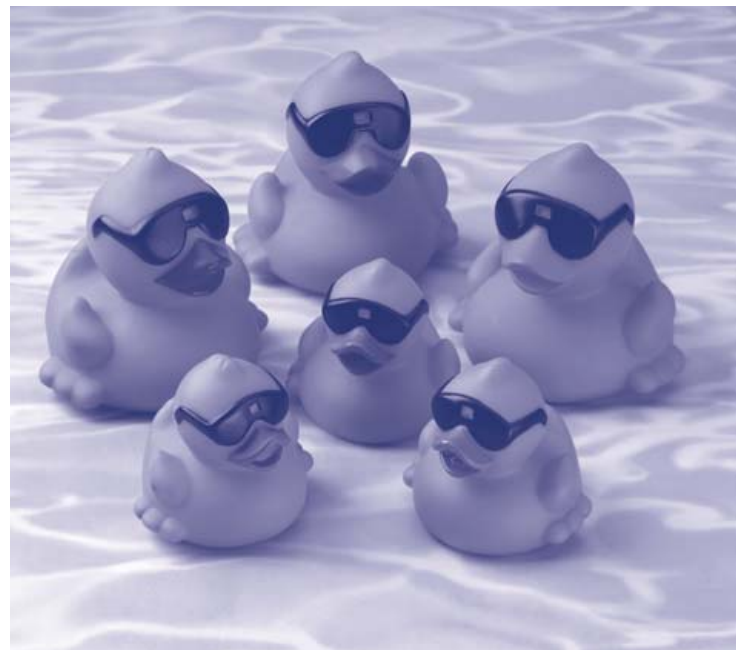

a machine shop outside of Buffalo, N.Y. He now works in Asbury's metal shop, repairing parts on walkers, wheelchairs and appliances. When residents offer to pay him, he suggests that they give to the Benevolent Care Fund.

The couple strongly agree on the importance of benevolent care. Marsh helps Development Director Pam Shubert visit new residents to explain the fund, and he recently joined the committee working on a new campaign for it. He explains, "It's a fair thing. Many of us don't

have unlimited funds—and it could be any of us who run out of money. Asbury won't put you out on the street." Fran adds, "When you think of the cost of nursing care, you're glad to know benevolent care is there!"

In addition to community volunteer work, Fran and Marsh have also helped organize an Asbury~Solomons Island resident trip. "We're the bus parents!" jokes Fran happily. Says Marsh, "We like to help when we can. And we like to continue staying busy!"

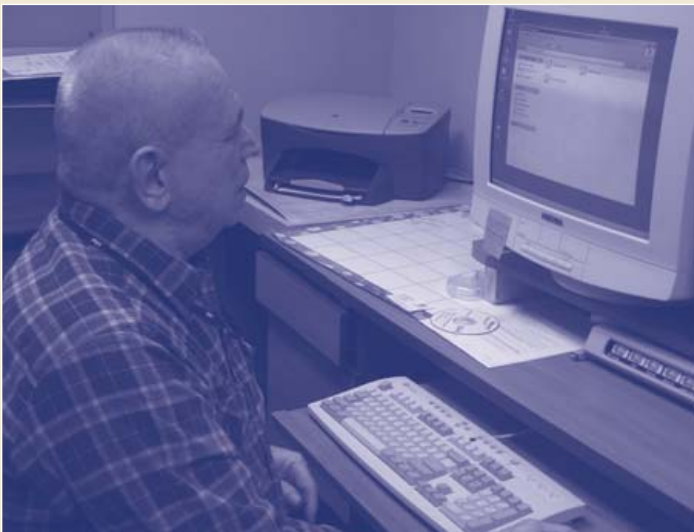
